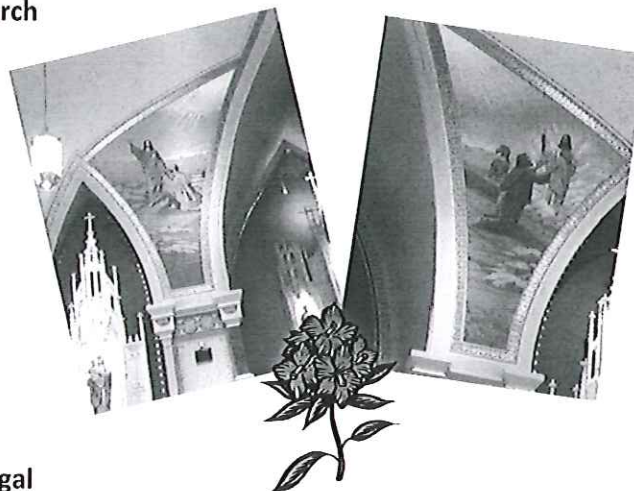

Saints Peter and Paul School—Security Updates



Saints Peter and Paul School are currently making strides in protecting our most precious asset and the future of our Parish- “Our Children”.! We are looking at Systems added to both the Elementary and Junior High School buildings.

We aren’t taking these steps as a result of any incident(s) that have occurred recently, but as a Pro-Active approach. We have developed a master plan to be implemented. We would rather be “Safe than Sorry”, for not taking any action. The following improvements are needed:

- Replace the existing exterior doors on North and south side of Junior High School building \$14,000
- Installing security surveillance in Grade school building \$12,000
- Installing security locking system to Grade school building iPhone and Access control \$ 5000
- Installing security surveillance in Junior High building \$9,000
- Installing security locking system to Junior High building iPhone and Access control \$ 5000



The improvements will be done on phases. We are requesting financial assistance to secure the building to protect the facilities for the safety of our children. Please send your contributions to the Parish office / Sts. Peter and Paul School.

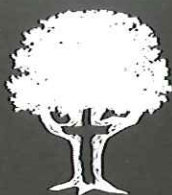
