Five Simple Ways to Make a Gift at Death

Provided by: The Catholic Foundation of Northeast Kansas (CFNEK)

- 1. Specific bequest This is a gift of a specific item to a specific beneficiary. For example, "I give my house to <parish name, city, state>." If that specific property has been disposed of before death, the bequest fails and no claim can be made to any other property.
- 2. General bequest This is usually a gift of a stated sum of money. It will not fail, even if there is not sufficient cash to meet the bequest—even if other assets need to be sold. For example, "I give \$50,000 to parish name, city, state>."
- 3. Percentage Bequest This is a convenient way of making sure your heirs and those charities you support share in equal shares. "I give devise and bequeath my estate to each of my three children and <parish name, city, state> in equal shares."
- **5.** Beneficiary designation One of the simplest and cheapest ways to add charity to your estate plan is to change a beneficiary designation on retirement assets, IRAs or Life Insurance. A gift made this way does not pass through probate, and there is no charge to make these changes. Any asset with a beneficiary designation can have a full, partial, or contingent beneficiary. Consult your plan administrator or insurance company for a beneficiary change form. Simply insert the charity name and address into the form. If the full name doesn't fit in the space provided, ask for help from the company providing the form or CFNEK.
