

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

This summer, SPPS is planning to host a formation course for adults interested in becoming a volunteer catechist for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS.) CGS is a Montessori-based religious formation program for children, beginning at the age of 3. It seeks to create and facilitate a sacred, "hands-on" space for children. This space, called an *atrium*, is a place in which both the children and the catechist can hear, ponder, and celebrate the most essential mysteries of the Catholic faith. CGS was developed many years ago in Rome by Dr. Sofia Cavaletti, a Hebrew scripture scholar, in collaboration with Gianna Gobbi, a Montessori directress. CGS has spread to numerous countries worldwide. CGS was brought to Kansas over twenty years ago by Marilee Quinn and others at Sancta Maria Montessori School in Eudora, KS and St. John Catholic Church in Lawrence, KS.

SPPS currently has a Level 1 atrium for children age 3-6 and a Level 2 atrium for children age 6-9. SPPS offers CGS to children in Pre-K through Second grade. It is offered by trained volunteers and additional helpers. In the atrium you will find numerous materials that are often handmade. You will find a child-sized altar with the articles of the Mass, a raised surface map of the Land of Israel, a small table where the children can gather for prayer, materials for the Infancy Narratives, materials for the Parables of the Kingdom of God, and a small sheepfold with the Good Shepherd and sheep. In the atrium is a small wooden Last Supper with figures and a wooden City of Jerusalem map, among many other things.

CGS is not "academic" in nature. It is more about creating a prepared environment in which the relationship of God and the child can be respected and nurtured. Select bible verses are read and pondered that often co-inside with the liturgical calendar and also proclaim the most essential mysteries of the Catholic faith. The presentations are sensitive to the developmental age of the child.

The dates for the formation course for adults are June 8-11 and July 6-9, 2017. The formation leaders will be Marilee Quinn from Lawrence, KS and Jeanne Wichman from Lenexa, KS. Marilee is certified in CGS for children ages 3-12 and has been working with children in the atrium since 1990. She has served on teams for national formation courses and serves as a formation leader in Kansas City, Wichita, Oklahoma City, Dallas, and Corpus Christi. Jeanne is certified to work with children ages 3-12 years of age in CGS and has been serving children in the atrium since 1997. Jeanne studied under Rebekah Rojcewicz, an internationally recognized formation leader.

Please prayerfully consider if God is calling you to this ministry. It simply involves a love of God and love of children and takes only a couple hours a week. If you are interested in registering for the formation course or to learn more about CGS, please contact Angie Hammes. angiemhammes@gmail.com or 785-294-0442. Registration deadline is May 25, 2017.
