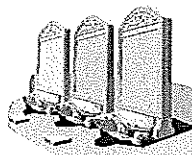
High School outdoor Mass and cook-out will be held Wednesday, April 30 at 6:30. Place will be announced later.

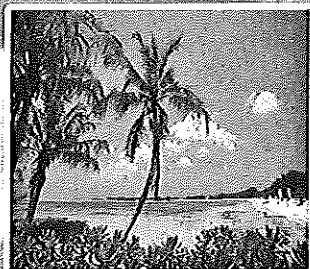
