Dance is from 8:30 to 11:30 PM at the SPPS Barn for those in 5th grade and up. Cost is \$4.00 per person.

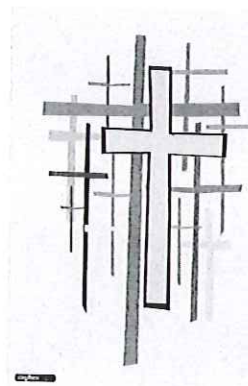

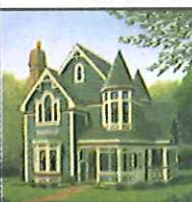
