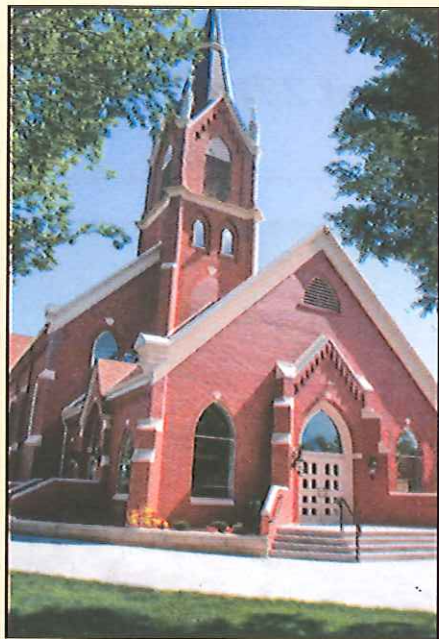

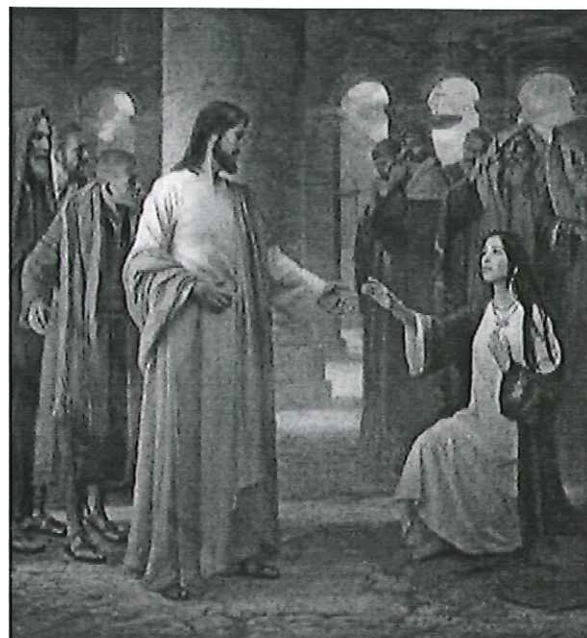
RCIA Classes for 2017-2018 will soon begin. An information meeting will be held

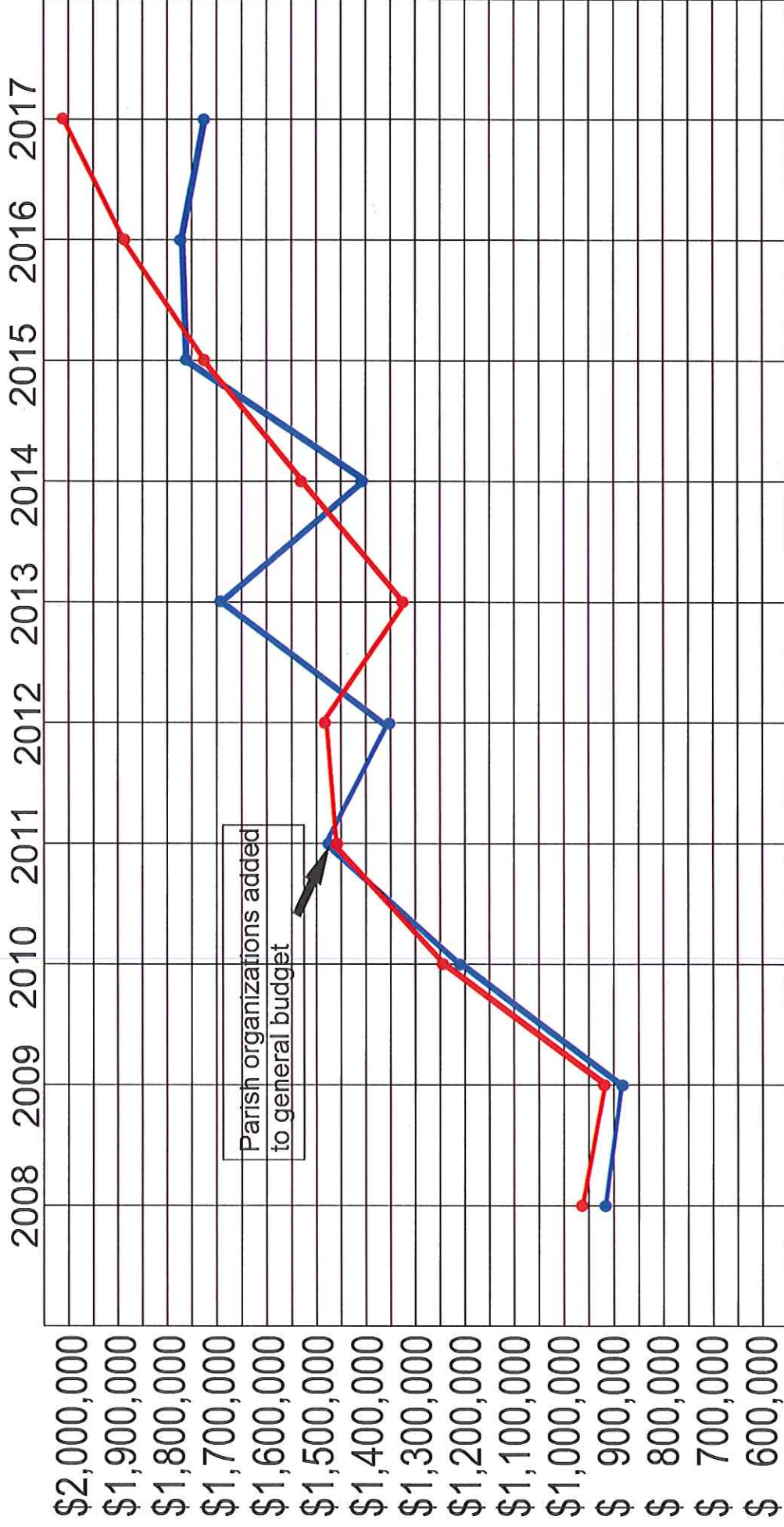
