
The SPPS PTO would like to extend their gratitude to all those who supported the "Stuff the Bus" wish list this year. Many of



### Marriage Minute - August 28

What is the opposite of love?

If you said hate, you are probably in agreement with most people, but John Paul II had a different opinion. He wrote that love is opposite in use. In today's Gospel, Jesus asks his disciples to examine their intentions as they invite guests to a party. Did they invite someone only to get an invite in return?

It may seem strange, but even in marriage, we need to guard against using one another. We can check the purity of our intentions by asking ourselves:

- Am I performing a kind act in order to get a specific response from my spouse?
- Is this action coming from a joyful heart, or out of a desire to not "be in the doghouse?"
- Do I keep track of good deeds, words or even intimacy?

If you answered "yes", ask Jesus to purify your intentions.
