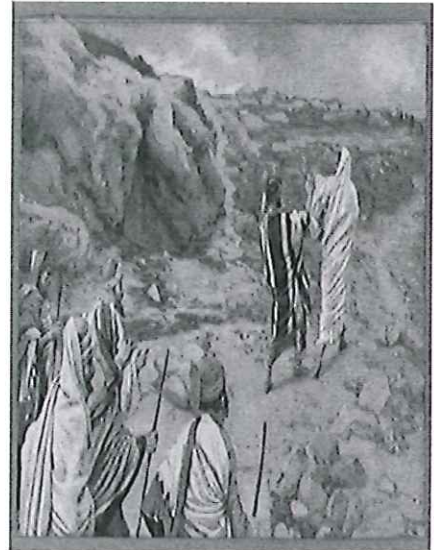
This month's recipient of the "Knight of the Month" award goes to Shawn Kramer, a K of C Council Officer. Congratulations, Shawn.

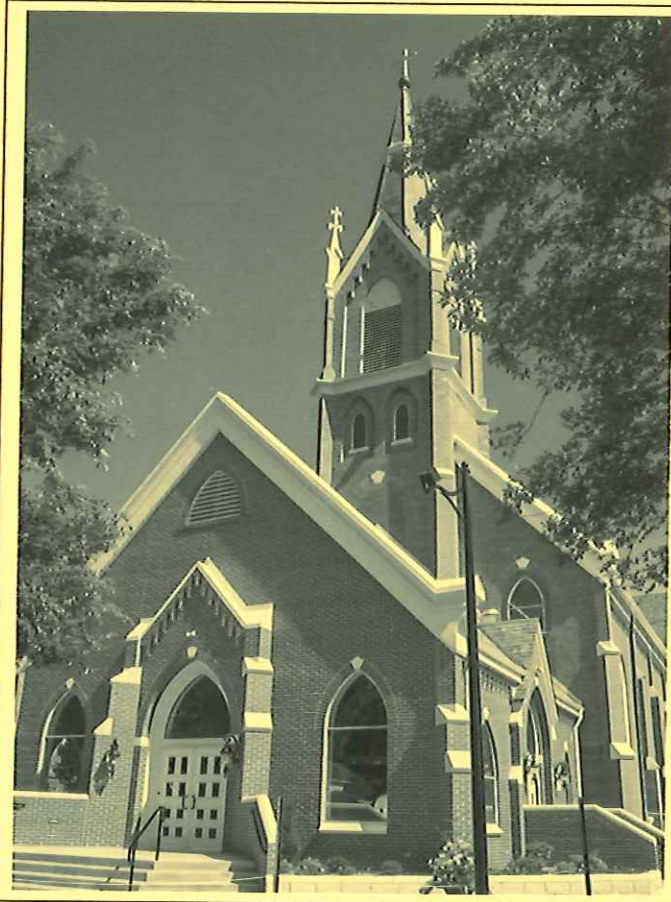
