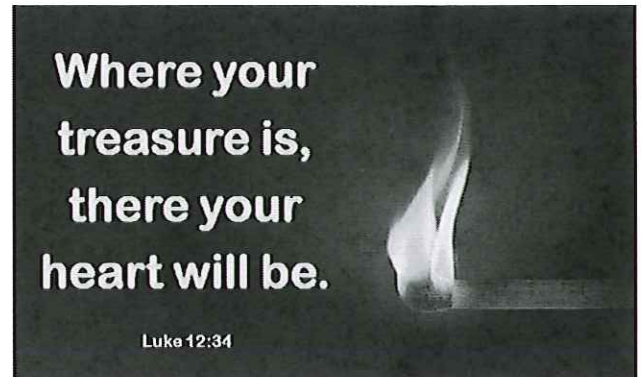
SPPS PTO "Stuff the Bus" Wish List
