Lenten Regulations:

Abstain from Meat on all Fridays in Lent – for all Catholics who have reached the age of reason and older. Fast and Abstain on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: All Catholics are obliged to fast by eating one normal and two lesser meals, with no eating between meals on these two days.

<u>Personal Fasting</u>: The Church asks that all Catholics find opportunities during Lent for personal fasting, along with prayer, frequent attendance at weekday Mass, the sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation, and positive works of charity and mercy.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be our focus this Lent. Confessions will be heard every Wednesday during Lent from 6-7 PM, and at 2:30 - 3:30 PM on Saturdays. "God waits for us. Always." - Pope Francis
