

This allows individuals who are  $70\frac{1}{2}$  or older to take their annual IRA withdrawal requirement and give it directly to charity for tax-free rollovers. You have until April 15, 2017 to make an IRA transfer for your 2016 tax year. The IRA distribution must be made directly to the charity, if it is made out to you, then taxes will be owed. 
