WHAT IS NFP? Natural Family Planning (NFP) is a generic title for scientific, natural and moral methods of family planning that assist married couples to identify the times when they can either achieve or postpone pregnancies.

NFP methods are based on the observation of the naturally occurring signs and symptoms of the fertile and infertile phases of a woman's menstrual cycle. When a woman learns to chart her fertility cycle, the couple can confidently identify days of fertility and infertility. It can also be an excellent health record that can aid the physician in diagnosing and treating underlying reproductive and gynecological health problems.

The methods of NFP respect the love-giving (unitive) and life-giving (procreative) nature of the conjugal act, thus they support God's design for married love! NFP is a way of life based on love that respects the dignity of the total person!

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF NFP? It is medically safe. No drugs, devices, or surgical procedures are used to avoid pregnancy. Promotes intimacy and requires communication. Ongoing communication and creative means of showing affection are a part of a successful NFP lifestyle, with mutual responsibility by husband and wife. Versatility: NFP can be used successfully during regular or irregular cycles, after coming off the pill or other chemical birth control methods, after childbirth, during breast-feeding and nearing menopause. NFP can be used throughout a woman's life!

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST? Introductory sessions in our region are free and come with a chart and the stamps you need to get started charting, as well as your first follow up session! A nominal fee for subsequent sessions is requested, however, you are never denied for inability to pay.

WHEN CAN WE START? For the engaged couple, 6 months prior to the wedding date is ideal to allow you to understand your cycle well in advance. For the married couple, you can learn as soon as possible.

HOW DO I LEARN NFP? The first step is to register for a class. The third Monday of every month there is an introductory session held at 7PM in the Sts. Peter and Paul education room (in the Junior High building). This session gives an overview of the use of the Creighton Model Fertility Care System to monitor a woman's reproductive and gynecological health. Following the Introductory session, there are a series of follow-up sessions that can further support a woman, and/or the couple, through the learning and use of the system.


