FINANCIAL NEWS: Congress has now approved the IRA Direct Rollover permanently. This allows individuals who are $70\frac{1}{2}$ or older to take <u>tax-free</u> rollovers from their IRA, provided the money goes directly to charity. By doing this, the annual withdrawal requirement can be fulfilled without incurring a tax liability. You have until April 15, 2017 to make an IRA transfer for your 2016 tax year. This provision is limited to IRA accounts. Funds in a 401k account must be transferred to an IRA before a direct transfer can be made to charity. The IRA distribution must be made directly to the charity, if it is made out to you, then taxes will be owed. Call Gary Pratt at 913-205-4376 at Arch KCKS for more info. Remember your parish in this charity rollover.

Don't forget the Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of KCKS Collection. Help them by placing your check in the Sunday Collection marked "Catholic Charities" in the memo area of the check.

Epiphany – The Feast of the Three Kings

20 + C + M + B + 17

Blessing the home for the year is an Epiphany Custom. In that spirit, you may bless your home too. Mark above the entry doors with chalk:



20+C+M+B+17



This symbol is made from the year split in two with initials for the traditional names of the three Wise Men: Caspar, Melchior and Balthazar.

The three letters also stand for <u>Christus Mansionem Benedicat</u>, meaning "Christ bless this home."

After marking the doorways, sprinkle the doorway and the rooms with holy water and pray:

"Lord, fill this home with kindness for one another, respect for guests, and the wisdom to seek Jesus always."

The sign above the door is meant to protect the house for the coming year, and the blessing symbolizes the family's commitment to welcome Christ into their homes on a daily basis throughout the year.


