

<u>Eucharistic Adoration</u> is a time-honored practice of spiritual exchange in front of the Blessed Sacrament. To spend time in Eucharistic Adoration puts you in the Presence of God Almighty. It involves a communion of hearts, which means a communion of love.

"Can you not watch with me one hour?" This was Jesus' request of His apostles on the night before His Passion and Death. It is the reason why a 'holy hour' has become the recommended time to spend with Christ, especially in Eucharistic Adoration. But it is an hour that must be considered a moment of love and grace.

Adoration represents "an extension of the Eucharist in which Christ gives Himself as our Living Bread for our spiritual life. This is a time to listen to God and to speak to him of our problems, our faults, our hopes, but most of all of our love and gratitude for Him.

The Adoration Chapel needs adorers for Saturdays 11-12 AM and 12-1 PM, and for Sundays 6-7 AM.
