The Path to the Calvary Grotto at Sts. Peter and Paul Cemetery

We are fortunate in that our ancestors during the 1870s selected four acres of land at this location, ½ mile north of Seneca, to serve as the final resting place for our Parish members. In 1902 the Edward and Elizabeth Boeding Family donated a Calvary, which consisted of Mary, Mary Magdalene, and the Crucifix. The Calvary's location and structure remained untouched for over 100 years. In 2010, Father Mike Koller approached the Quilters of Sts. Peter & Paul about repainting the iron structures and updating the Calvary's general appearance. In the renovation process, Mary and Mary Magdalene were able to be saved; unfortunately, due to years of exposure to the elements, the crucifix was beyond repair. Father Mike Koller and the Quilters instructed me order a lost wax bronze crucifix from Italy. In 2012, I visited with Father Arul Carasala about his thoughts and plans for the Calvary, so we could complete the project. He pulled out a piece of paper from his desk and drew out his vision for the site. Mark and Rosie Fangman, over the years had often expressed to me their desire to leave statues of St. Peter & St. Paul to the cemetery. Their children fulfilled this wish by instructing me to commission these bronze statues, also from Italy. Furthermore, they honored their parent's wish by donating the funds to build a wall, which would encompass the statues. During the development and completion of this project, funds from other parishioners were also donated to bring water and electricity to the cemetery. On behalf of the Cemetery Board, I would like to say, "Thank You," to those who donated funds, volunteered their time to sow the grass, water the plantings, and who worked on this project to make this Calvary Grotto a reality—something we can be proud of for another 100 plus years. May all the souls of the faithful departed rest in Peace!
