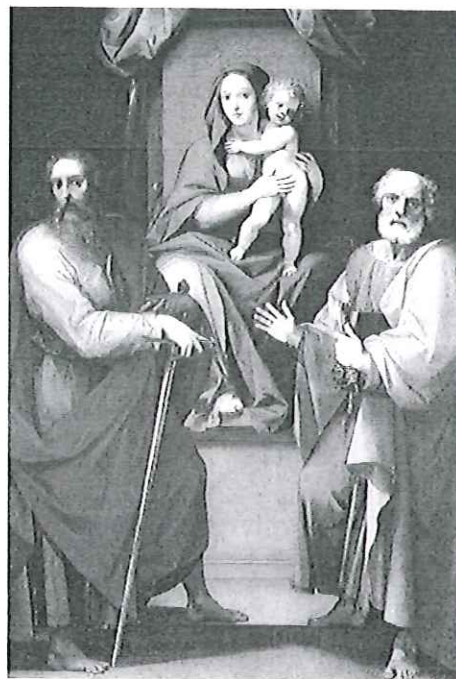

- Pray to see the situation from your spouse's point of view.
- Clarify and make sure you are communicating what you intend.
- Focus on the value behind your different views instead of on any one behavior.

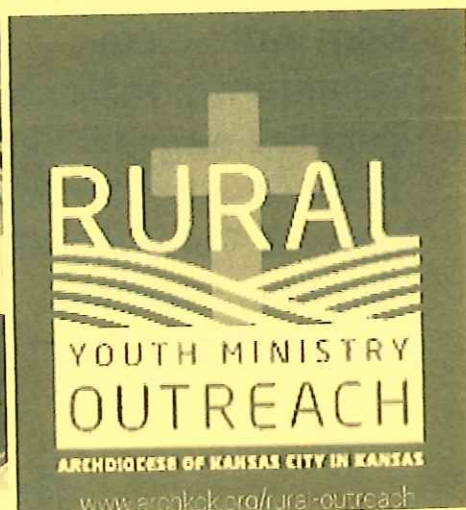
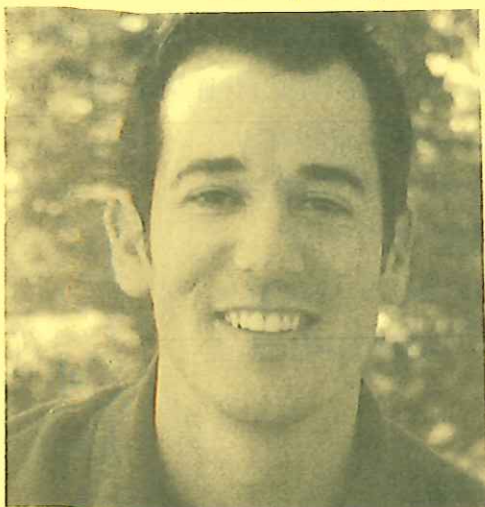
