<u>Make a Gift through an IRA Charitable Rollover</u> -The "Fiscal Cliff" tax legislation that was just enacted extends the opportunity throughout 2013 for individuals $70\frac{1}{2}$ or older to make a direct distribution from your IRA to a qualified charity such as your parish, Archbishop's Call to Share, an endowment or fund at the Catholic Foundation of NE Kansas or another archdiocesan institution or ministry or another qualified charity. Such qualified direct distributions to charity from your IRA are not subject to income tax. The new law also provides that you may consider such distributions made in January 2013 as made in 2012. In addition, the new law provides a special election available to individuals who took a distribution from their IRA after 11-30-2012 & before 1-1-2013, & who make a gift to a gualified charity before 2-1-<u>Make a Gift through an IRA Charitable Rollover</u> who make a gift to a gualified charity before 2-1-2013, to treat the gift as an IRA charitable rollover even though the distribution is not directly from the IRA charity.
