The Cobian-Rivera family of our parish wants to celebrate a 500+ year old Mexican tradition with prayer, Christmas carols, and more. The tradition of Las Posadas starts

on Dec 16 and goes to Christmas eve. Las Posadas literally means "the inns". The festival is based around a reenactment of Joseph & Mary trying to find lodging at numerous inns in Bethlehem and being turned away. The procession goes from house to house (i.e. "inn" to "inn") with adults in Nativity costumes and children following them with candles.
