30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Feast Day of All Saints, (a Holyday of Obligation) falls on Sunday, November 1, this year. Traditionally the month of November has been dedicated by the Church to praying for the suffering souls in Purgatory and our Faithful Departed. At each Mass next weekend, we will commemorate all who have been buried in our parish from November 1st to October 31st. Wooden crosses at the Main Altar will honor each deceased person. Their names will be read at each Mass and will be inscribed in a Book of Remembrance at St. Joseph's altar. Parishioners are invited to take their loved one's cross after Mass. The names of any of your deceased loved ones may be added to the Remembrance Book on the pages following the inscription page.


