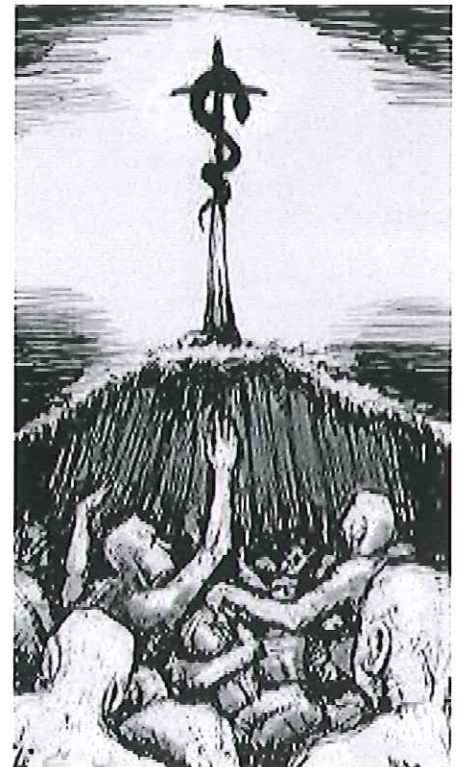
NOTES ON SPORTS SCHEDULE:

Jesus, teaching through our Church, has always taught that temptations come from the world, the flesh, and the devil. Jesus respects your free will. Do you want to follow Him or not? In order to stay a strong follower of Jesus Christ, it is critical that you let God nourish you and let the saints intercede for you. Consider the following things in order to grow in your faith and love:

-Read Sacred Scripture daily. Really focus and reflect on the four Gospels.

- In addition to going to Mass for your Sunday obligation, make time to go to daily Mass. We believe that Jesus is in the Eucharist; we should want to come to Him and receive Him as often as possible before we die.

-Let Jesus cleanse you frequently in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. What excuse do you have for not going six to twelve times a year? Fear? "My parents did not go"? "I don't believe in it"? Jesus wants you to go.

-Be sure your home is loaded up with crucifixes, pictures of Jesus & Mary and the saints, and a holy water font.

-Have your home blessed by a priest or deacon.

-Ask your guardian angel to help you each day, and ask for St. Michael's protection.

-Pray the Rosary and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy every day. Mary will crush the head of Satan.

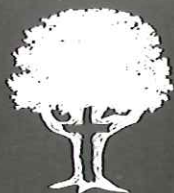
