animals to the Parish parking lot at 9 AM for a blessing of the animals this Saturday.



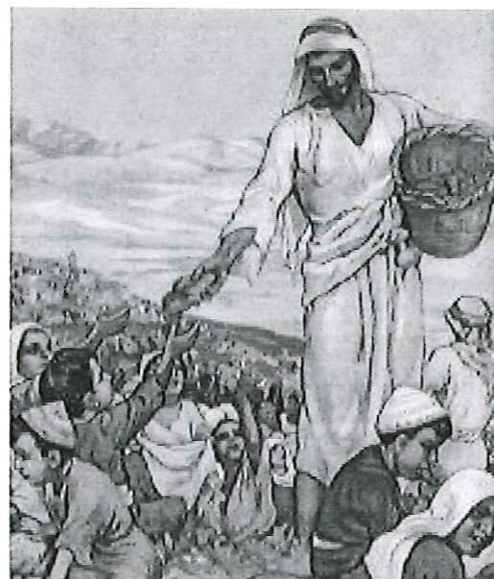
Adult Choir Practice is again this week. Practice is on Tues Sept 29, at 7:00 PM.
