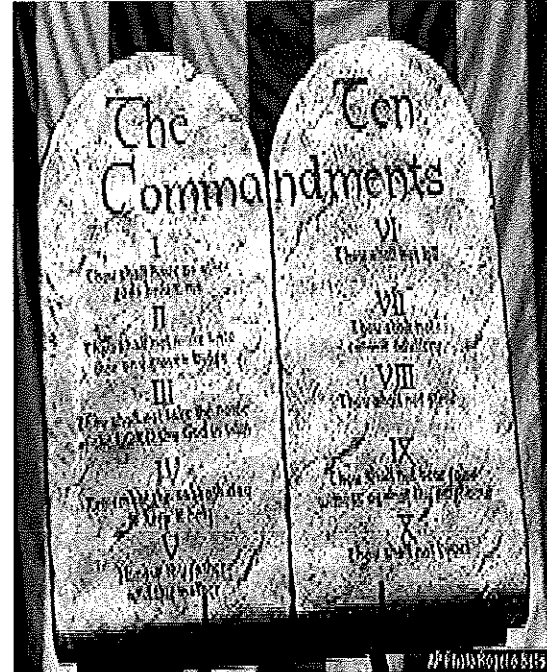
Adult Choir Practice will be Tuesday Sept. 16 at 7 PM. and every Tuesday there-after unless notified. New members always welcome.

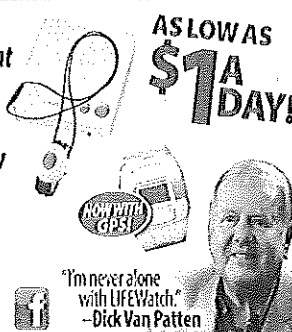
