Our participation in supporting the efforts of "Kansans for Life" through the <u>Baby Bottle Program</u> was again a great success this year. By handing out baby bottles on Mother's Day and having them returned by Father's Day, the members of our parish were again given the opportunity to support the efforts of Kansans for Life. The total amount donated this year was \$3286.06.

Kansans for Life is a nonprofit educational organization dedicated to protecting and defending the right to life of all humans from the moment of conception to natural death. They offer, free to the public, educational items and information, pregnancy help and referrals, libraries in each of their offices, pro-life speakers, media representation, as well as sponsor educational forums and events on various aspects of the sanctity of human life issue. Their legislative department offsets pro-choice lobbyists and presents a professional pro-life voice in the Kansas Legislature, and their political action committee endorses pro-life candidates during elections.
