





Peter and Paul donated the Calvary statues; Mark & Rosie Fangman donated the statues of Sts. Peter and Paul, the monument wall and landscaping; Luckeroth Masonry donated the labor for the wall; K of C for tomb of the unborn. Now we are accepting donations to cover the cost of lighting at the Calvary (\$2500) and the cost of water line (\$3973). We will have it all ready by this Memorial Day, May their souls rest in peace!
