There will be a Healing Mass on Ascension Thursday, May 29<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 PM with anointing of the sick following Mass.

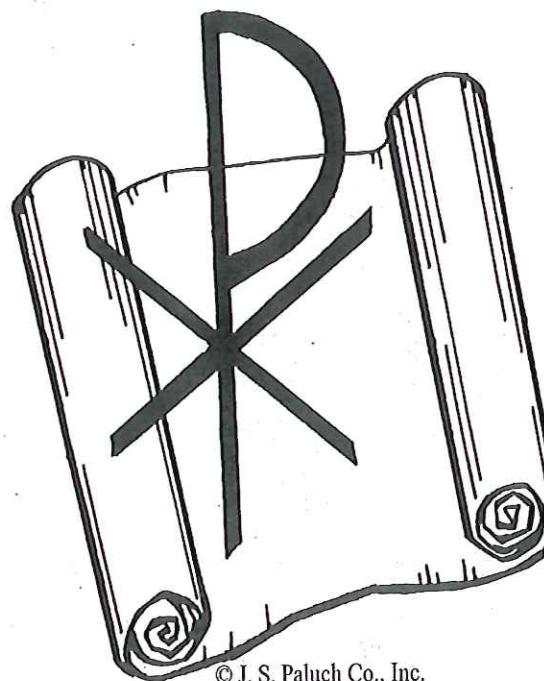
