### There will be a Kids Summer Lunch Program

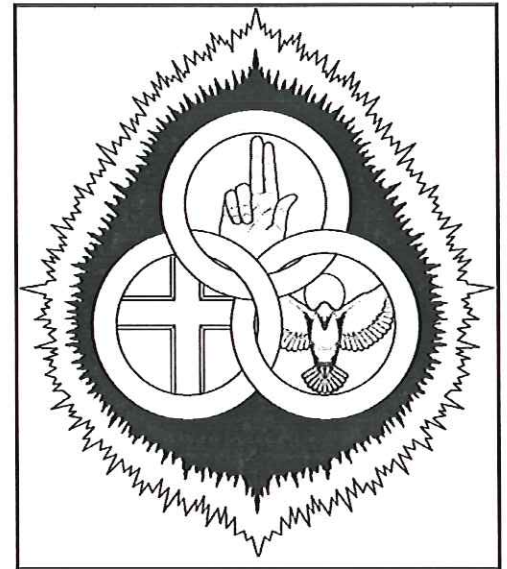

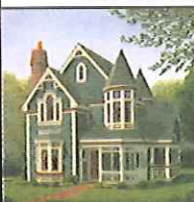
