Lenten Regulations :

Abstain from Meat on all Fridays in Lent:- For all Catholics who have reached the age of reason and older Fast & Abstain on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. All Catholics age 18 to 59 are obliged to fast by eating one normal meal and two lesser meals, with no eating between meals on those two days.

Personal Fasting: It is recommended that all Catholics find opportunities during Lent to compliment their fasts with prayer, frequent attendance at daily Mass, the sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation, and positive works of charity and mercy.




