Mass and at Good Friday Services.

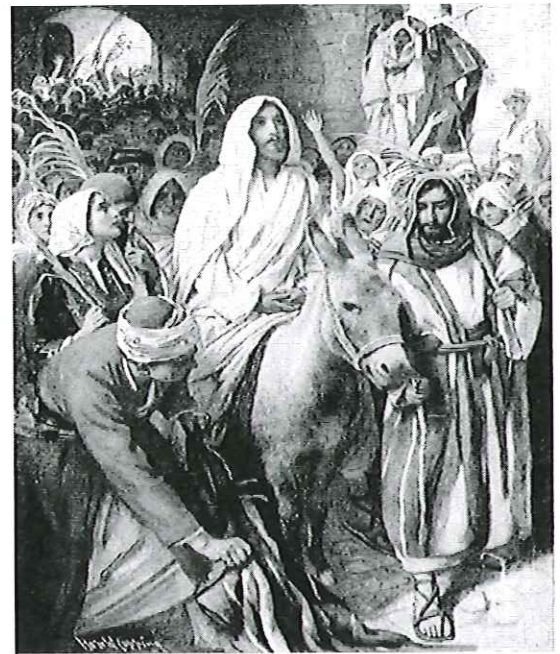
