### Evangelization: Give it a "Kick Start"

#### "Together We Grow in Faith"

The greater part of evangelization is inviting others into a "space," a situation where they can meet God. To be sure that we are not making evangelization more complicated and difficult than it is, we need to realize that it's the work of the grace of God. We are simply facilitators. Matthew invited Jesus to his house for a meal, along with his fellow tax collectors. Matthew simply facilitated the meeting between Jesus and his friends. In our situations, without Jesus' visible, physical presence, it is a bit more mysterious for us, but our essential role is still the same. We invite others to places where the encounter between them and Jesus can most likely occur.

We had two candidates who came to RCIA last year just because their friends had invited them to go along with them to Catholic Heart Work Camp. It triggered them to explore the Catholic Faith. Now they are very regular practicing Catholics in our parish. You can do many things similar in your own situations. For instance, invite someone to go to confession with you on Saturdays, or to Mass on Sundays. Invite a friend to join you for a group Rosary. Take your children or grandchildren along with you when going to Adoration, or when taking Communion to the sick and home bound. These are all occasions where they can meet the Lord Jesus Christ. You are doing what St. Matthew did - more mysterious - but the same. Our job is to give it that "kick start", and it will give them an idea to explore their faith. Let us be Matthew to our friends and neighbors. -Fr. Arul
