Integrated Evangelization

"Together We Grow in Faith"

In the first column, I emphasized the Church's constant teaching that evangelization is primarily the role of the laity. The ordained clergy exist to feed, teach, and heal the souls of the laity so that the laity can bring Christ and the Gospel to others and others to Christ. The first step in becoming a parish that evangelizes well (and don't we at Sts. Peter and Paul, Seneca want to evangelize well?) is for the laity to accept this mission from Jesus and carry it out in an intentional way. The second column focused on our need to simplify our understanding of evangelization. If we don't, we will lack confidence and desire to actually do it. We will think that we are not holy enough or intelligent enough or well-spoken enough or theologically inclined enough or enough time, etc. However, it's not that complicated. All that is required is:

1. To be convinced that a relationship with Christ and the Church is a tremendous treasure of your life, AND
2. To want others to have that treasure. If one possesses these two, then one will naturally bring them to one's relationships. Evangelization will be integrated into one's daily life. This is what Andrew did in the Gospel of John. Andrew met Jesus and became convinced that he was the Messiah—the treasure. He wanted his brother Peter to have that same treasure, so Andrew brought Peter to Jesus. Andrew's evangelization was integrated into his relationship with Peter. It is not meant to be complicated.

I have seen seven batches go through RCIA in Seneca. There is a story behind every one of those who came to

class. Common phenomena in all cases were, "Someone (friend, classmate, coworker who is a Catholic, participating in camps like Kelly Youth Rally, CHWC, Sports event etc.) invited them to think about the Catholic faith". A husband and wife came to become Catholic. When asked what caused them to want to become Catholic, the husband said that he started spending more time with a co-worker who is Catholic. Over time he became interested in the Faith and started asking the Catholic man questions about it. The two of them had good conversations, and eventually his fellow employee suggested that the couple call the Catholic Church. That's why this couple is Catholic today: because a blue-collar Catholic man, brought in his own way, the treasure of the faith into a relationship in his daily life, into his relationship with his coworker. He was not preachy; he was not pushy—he was a man who was intentional about drawing another to the Faith and integrated it into his daily life. All of us can do this. May the Holy Spirit free us and teach us how to be intentional and integrated in sharing the Faith. -Fr. Arul.

Being a Godly Father

Being a godly father is neither easy or simple. Any man who is a father knows that it comes with challenges, struggles, and even some failures. But God honors fathers. He created fathers as the example of Christ to the family (Eph. 5:21-32) and gives them responsibility for godly discipline (Eph. 6:4). He sees fathers as His instrument of compassion (Ps. 103:13) and His method to train children to love Him (Deut. 6:5-7). This honored position given to all fathers by God is a reason to approach fatherhood with joy and pride.

Following Christ's Example

The honored place of representing Christ comes with many implications. Fathers should be forgiving like Christ (Mt. 6:12) and loving like Him (Jn. 3:16). They should accept their children (Mt. 9:11-12) and love them even though they have faults (Lk. 5:31-32). They should have patience (Lk. 22:32-34) and even have righteous anger when God's design is being corrupted (Mt. 21:12-13).

Accepting Christ's Forgiveness

All fathers should give their love first to God and then have their actions follow. Unfortunately, the one place we cannot follow Christ is in the perfection of His actions. In this God has provided. A godly father is not godly because of his own perfection; a godly father is godly because Christ has forgiven him. Living in this forgiveness removes the shame of failure and provides true motivation, the love of God, as the way to move forward.

If there is a mistake made, ask forgiveness. If actions fail, rejoice that Christ has made a way! Fatherhood will always stretch a man to grow, but with God's guidance, the growth will make a forgiven man into a godly father.
