Evangelization: Where Do We Start?

"Together We Grow in Faith"

How best we evangelize begins with us. We have a very rich history of claiming to be Traditional Catholics. We even take pride in claiming to be third or fourth generation Catholics. It's a great privilege, but at the same time, let us take a deep look into ourselves and see how seriously we take our faith.

The more we know Jesus and the more we are converted, the more we draw others to Jesus and into conversion. Throughout the gospels we see this dynamic in quite ordinary ways. The call of Matthew, the tax collector, in the Gospel of Matthew offers a simple but profound example: "As Jesus passed on from there, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at the customs post. He said to him, 'Follow me.' And he got up and followed him. While Matthew was at table in his house, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat with Jesus and his disciples."

Matthew meets Jesus, follows Him, and then "at table in his house", he introduces many other tax collectors to "Jesus and His disciples." There's the dynamic. Matthew is evangelized and then evangelizes; he meets Jesus and then introduces others to Jesus and to His Disciples—the Church. It is not complicated.

It's important that we understand what Matthew did. He simply invited them, drawing them into a situation where Jesus could meet them and they could meet Him. He facilitated the encounter between the "many tax collectors and sinners" and Jesus and the Church. That's all he did. This is much of the work of effectively evangelizing: inviting others into a space, a situation, where they can meet God in a real way.

In today's Gospel, Luke gives great emphasis to the birth of John the Baptist. Jesus said of him: "I tell you, among those born of women, no one is greater than John. Yet the least in the kingdom of God is greater than he".


