<u>Left-overs</u> will be for sale in the parish hall at 8:45 pm, and not before.



<u>Children's Choir</u> is for any child in the parish who is in 3rd grade to 8th grade. They sing in the months of September, November, January, March, and Mother's Day (Saturday night mass). We sing the 2nd Sunday of the month at the 9:00 Mass except on Mother's Day weekend (sing at 5:00 mass).

We also usually sing for Christmas and Easter. Sometimes the choir is asked to sing for other masses or events.

We practice 1 or 2 Wednesday nights in the church before the Sunday we sing. Children's Choir practices from 6:00 to 7 (before CCD). Of course, this may change sometimes. We try to e-mail the parents of when practice is and when we will sing and it is also announced in the bulletin. I usually get phone numbers and email addresses of the families at the first practice.

Our first practice will be on August 29 (& then again on September 5) at 6:00 in the church. (practice will last an hour) We will sing on September 9 at the 9:00 Mass.
