Think about being Free from Fear & Pressure

- 3. Remember you are offering something good to one another. I hear from some of you about what am I supposed to do when my children or grandchildren do not go to church? It is not only your duty but you also have an obligation to talk to them about the practice of their faith. One needs to keep in mind that authentic evangelization is about offering something very good to another. Offering food to a starving person should not cause me fear or pressure. Is that how we see our faith and the practice of it? Or do we see it as a burden, or a moralism? If we see it as a treasure in our own lives, then our invitation will be done out of the same interior place that we offer gifts. To see evangelization as an invitation to receive a gift reduces fear and pressure.
- 4. Accept that some may decline your invitation. St. Monica prayed for her son St. Augustine for 27 years. Yes, he rejected her for a very long time but she never gave up. We need to accept that not everyone will accept. This is very important and very freeing. It cuts through pressure. In the sixth chapter of the Gospel of St. John, Jesus gave His Bread of Life discourse on the Eucharist, His teaching on the Eucharist as His Flesh and Blood. When He finished, the gospel states that many of his disciples left Him. Not everyone accepts the invitation. We need to accept that. Persistence will pay off one day and it could be sometimes on their death bed. I see witnesses' conversion at their death bed also. -Fr Arul

My Dear Brother Priest:

I invite you and your parishioners to join me and Catholics nationwide in a weekly moment of prayer from early August to late September 2018 for the legal protection of human life.

As soon as Supreme Court Justice Anthony Kennedy announced his retirement, proabortion groups began lobbying the U.S. Senate to reject any nominee who does not promise to endorse *Roe v. Wade*. We should certainly raise grave concerns about a confirmation process that is being grossly distorted by efforts to subject judicial nominees to a litmus test of support for abortion. And we must pray.

Each Friday, from August 3 to September 28, 2018, we'll have the opportunity to join in a nine-week effort of prayer, fasting and education that a change in the U.S. Supreme Court will move our nation closer to the day when every human being is protected in law and welcomed in life.

As part of the USCCB Call to Prayer, participants can receive weekly prayer reminders by text message or email. In addition to the current invitation to fast on Fridays, participants will be encouraged to pray one *Our Father*, *Hail Mary*, and *Glory Be* for this intention and will receive important facts about how *Roe* is not health care, is bad law, and fails women.


