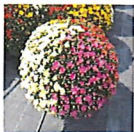
Adult Choir will begin practice on Tues September 25, at 7:00 PM. New members are always welcome. St. Augustine reminds us that "Singing is twice praying".

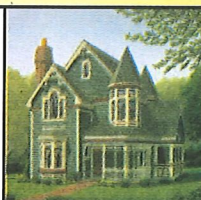
