<u>Lent begins this week with Ash Wednesday</u>

<u>Masses on Wed, March 6th at 6:00 AM, 8:00</u>

AM and 7:00 PM. The ashes we receive that

day symbolize two things: <u>death</u> and <u>repentance</u>. When we come forward to receive ashes, we are saying that we are sorry for our sins, that we want to use this season of Lent to correct our faults, purify our hearts, control our desires, and grow in holiness so we will be prepared to celebrate Easter with great joy.

Lenten Regulations:

Abstain from Meat on all Fridays in Lent: For all Catholics who have reached the age of reason and older Fast & Abstain on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday: All Catholics age 18 and older are obliged to fast by eating one normal meal and two lesser meals, with no eating between meals on those two days.

<u>Personal Fasting</u>: It is recommended that all Catholics find opportunities during Lent to compliment their fasts with prayer, frequent attendance at daily Mass, the Sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation, and positive works of charity and mercy.

Lenten Devotions:

Stations of the Cross: Every Friday at 2 PM, beginning March 15th, there will be Stations of the Cross for the school children and for all who wish to attend.

<u>Divine Mercy Chaplet</u>: <u>Every Thursday evening at 7:00</u> <u>PM</u>, beginning March 14th, we will join Katie Nordhus in singing the Divine Mercy Chaplet in our Church.






