Prayer & Action is still needing your help!

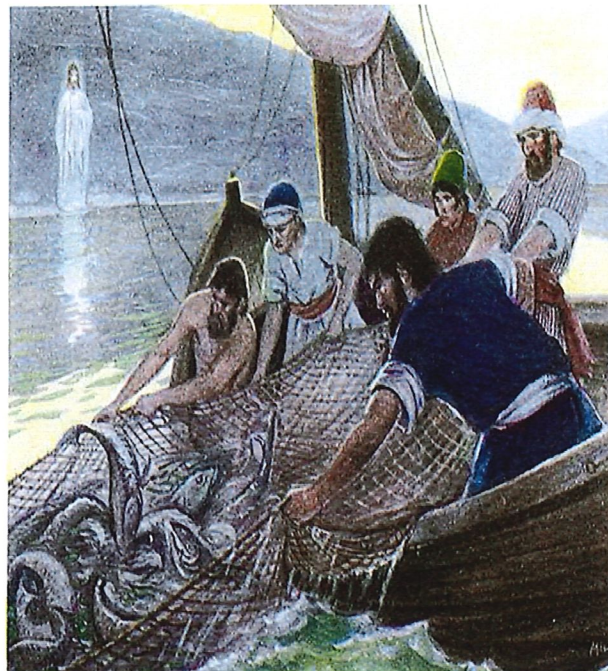
