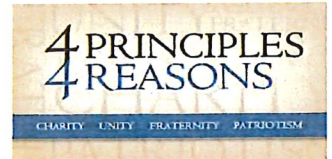
Reflections on Divine Mercy and the Eucharist

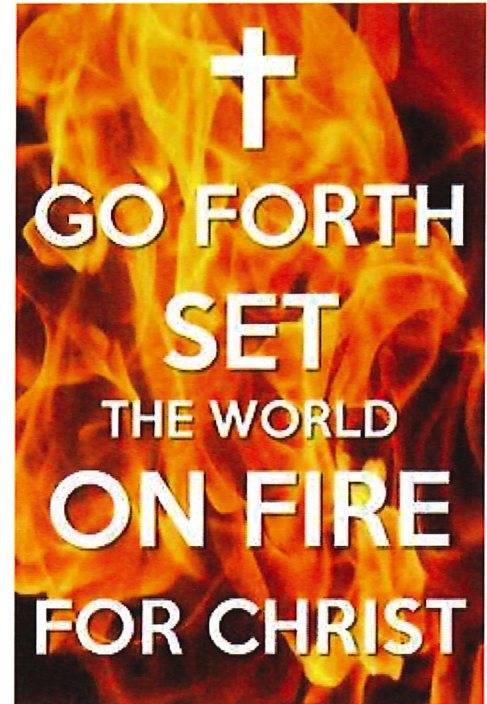

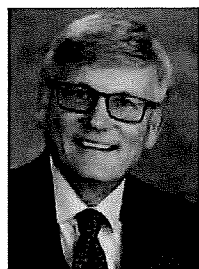
