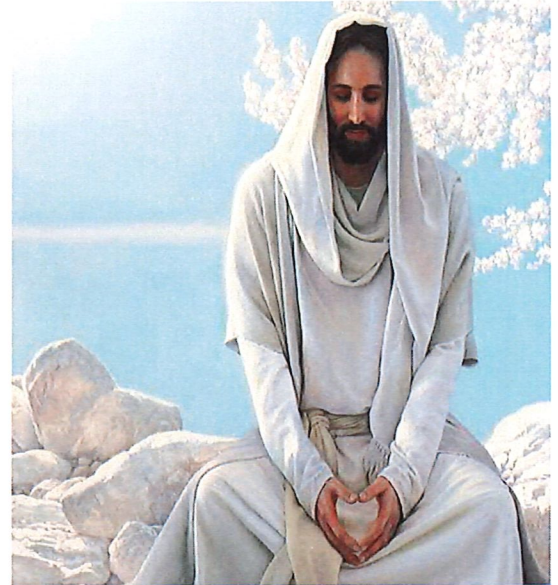

APPS

There are a variety of apps available for Apple and Android phones. Here are a few of our favorites:

- **iBreviary:** Pray the Liturgy of the Hours
- **3-Minute Retreat:** Very simple and straightforward, providing a quote from scripture to be read, followed by a quick reflection to meditate upon, ending with a brief prayer. *You can select English or Spanish.*
- **Pray As You Go:** Designed primarily to be listened to — while you are getting ready in the morning, on your drive to work or school, etc. — but also has text available to read. Includes music, a reading of scripture, and questions to meditate upon. Provides audio Stations of the Cross, reflections, and retreats, as well as other prayer tools.
- **Laudate:** A robust resource including daily readings, Liturgy of the Hours, Stations of the Cross, the Rosary and Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Examen for Confession, the Catechism, Vatican documents and more.
- **Jesuit Prayer:** Daily inspiration with scripture and reflection, a guide for the Examen, and the option of setting reminders for praying the Daily Inspiration and Examen.
