The Knights of Columbus has made some membership changes this past year. The Knights have recently launched the **E-Member Program**. An E-Member is a web-based recruiting program to help eligible Catholic men join the Knights. Any Catholic male above 18 years of age can join as a Knight online. Then that person has a choice whether he wants to stay in the E-Member division or become a Knight by joining the 1st degree. An E-Member is eligible for insurance and other benefits through the Knights. However, he cannot be a member of any council or does not have any voting rights until he is admitted in the 1st degree. This program is designed to help men who may not have time to join but still want the benefits that the Knights offer until they are able to go through the admissions degree.
