- Fast & Abstain on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. All Catholics are obliged to fast by eating one normal meal and two lesser meals, with no eating between meals on those two days.
- Personal Fasting: It is recommended that all Catholics find opportunities during Lent to compliment their fasts with prayer, frequent attendance at daily Mass, and positive works of charity and mercy.

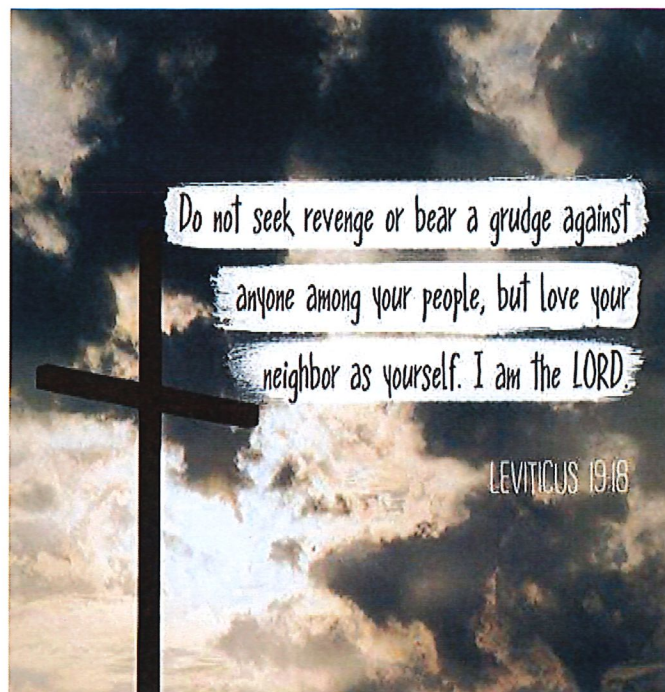
