- ❖ Servers: Robes will not be worn until the ordinance is over, so boys please wear a tie and girls dress appropriately.
- ❖ This ordinance will continue until June 15.

- ❖ Adoration chapel will remain closed for now. However, there will be adoration in the church every Saturday right after the 7:30 AM mass until 4:00 PM.

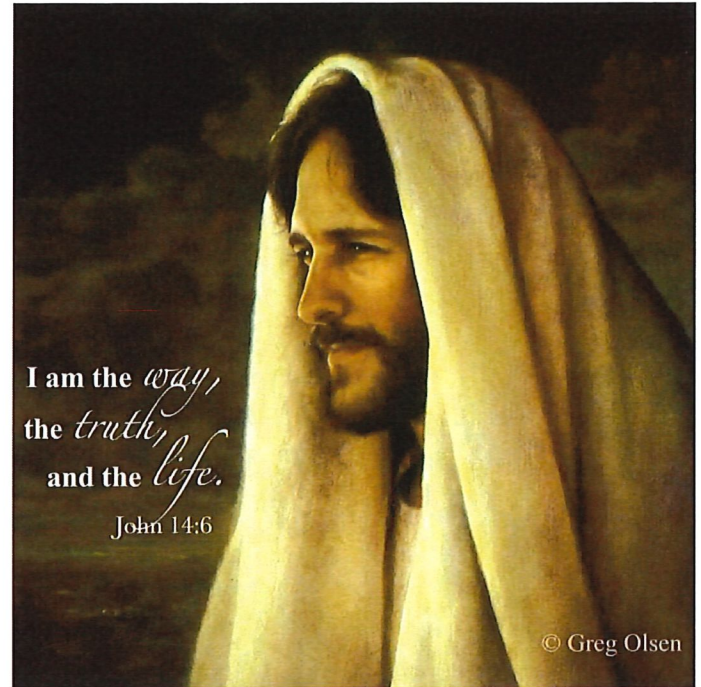
