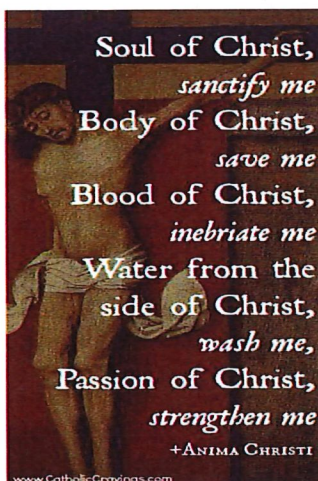


Monthly Livestream Rosary for Healing and Protection
