<u>Catechetical Sunday</u> will be celebrated next Sunday, Sept. 20, at the 9:00 AM mass. All school teachers, CCD



COVID GUIDELINES

Protocols for Volleyball Competitions:

- All people who enter the building will be required to wear masks.
- Spectators Dual 4 per athlete, Triangular 2 per athlete.
- Temperature checks will be taken at the entrance of the building.
- Families are strongly encouraged to sit together in groups in the bleachers.
- All children must sit with their parents for the entire game.
- SPPS fans shall sit on the home side of the gym, on the north end.
- Visiting fans will sit in the visitor's section on the south end.
- Spectators shall sit in their assigned section of the gym for their school, and not intermingle with guests from different schools.
- Spectators shall not gather in the commons area other than as families.
- Athletes and coaches are required to wear masks other than when they are participating on the court.
- Locker rooms will not be available for visiting teams unless previous arrangements are made.
- Visiting teams are to bring their own volleyballs for warmups.
- Concession Stand will be limited to drinks and prepackaged food.

Protocols for Football Competitions:

- Spectators are strongly encouraged to wear masks when social distancing is not possible.
- Families are strongly encouraged to stand or sit together in groups,
- Teams will not be provided a locker room for pregame, halftime, or postgame team discussion, unless weather conditions necessitate it.
- The chain gang will be on the home sideline.
- Concession Stand will be available.

5:00 p.m.- Mass with special music

In addition to September 26, September 19-28 are also days set apart for prayer and fasting for conversions across the globe. Again, we have wonderful opportunities to join in prayer throughout this time in our parish. On Monday evenings at 7:00 PM the Patriotic Rosary is offered, and of course, there are the Sunday Masses. Pray during your adoration hour, pray with your family, pray as an individual...just pray! Then trust that our prayers will join with those of Christians all around this country and the world, and that our Almighty, all Loving, all Forgiving God will have mercy on us as individuals and as a nation and we can **return** to **One Nation under God!**
