Planned Giving Brief: End of the Year Tax Planning Congress enacted two tax provisions to encourage charitable donations before the end of 2020. These include:

- 1. Increase in tax deduction for cash gifts: For donors that itemize their tax return, before the new legislation, the annual income limit was capped at 60% for cash gifts. The new legislation allows for charitable donations up to 100% of a donor's annual income.
- 2. New deduction: If you do not itemize when filing your tax return, to reduce your tax liability, you will be allowed to take a special tax deduction of up to \$300 for charitable donations.

## Sts. Peter and Paul Church

#### December 15, 2020

Dear Father,

Each year during the Advent season, we prepare our hearts to welcome again the love of God revealed in Jesus. This year we also prepare for the official close of the *One Faith*, *One Family*, *One Future in Christ* campaign. In 2020 you have each been called to embrace new challenges in the daily life of your parish and community. You have tended to the needs of your parishioners through times of crisis while also taking important steps to strengthen our Church for generations to come. I am always edified and filled with gratitude for all that you do.

While we work hard to receive decisions from as many households as possible, it is important to also reflect on the fruits of your labor. As of November, cash from campaign gifts has been fully allocated to fund the evangelization initiative, priest retirement residence and priest residence endowment. Existing pledges are projected to complete funding for Villa St. Francis improvements in 2022 and the priest pension plan in 2023. In addition, more than \$1 million is currently projected for the property revitalization fund, which is the case element that will continue to benefit from new commitments until that fund has been filled.

Thankfully, we continue to experience the generosity of Catholic families across our Archdiocese. The *One Faith* campaign has generated \$2 million in new cash and commitments from more than 1,000 donors since the end of March. Giving has steadily increased each week since August. While the projections above reflect commitments received as of November, there is even more that we can accomplish in the short time remaining.

I need your continued dedication to finish the year strong. While we cannot control how families have been impacted by COVID-19 or whether they will choose to support our efforts, we can work to receive decisions from as many families as possible. Please continue to follow up with key donors in your parish who have not yet made a campaign decision and to broadly communicate to all parishioners the good work of the *One Faith* campaign. This applies not only to Block Three parishes, but also to parishes who completed the campaign in earlier phases. The end of the year lends a sense of urgency and is a time when many families make decisions regarding their charitable support. Let us work together to make the most of this opportunity to strengthen our Church.

Please accept my heartfelt gratitude for your leadership and hard work that has been essential for the success of the *One Faith, One Family, One Future in Christ* campaign. Your support has helped to ensure our ability to maintain a strong and vital Church in each of the 21 counties we serve in Northeast Kansas.
