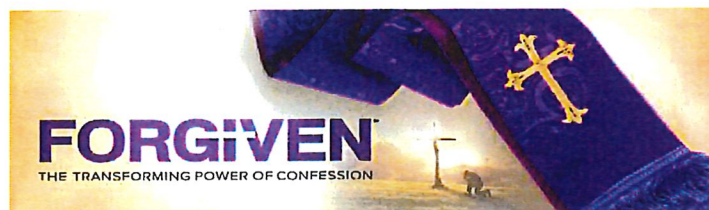

The Evangelization Team at Saints Peter & Paul is conducting a Lenten Parish Mission: **FORGIVEN**. The past year has been a time of testing to live in the state of grace.
