****Come to Confession:** During Lent, confession is available on Wednesdays from 6-7 PM.

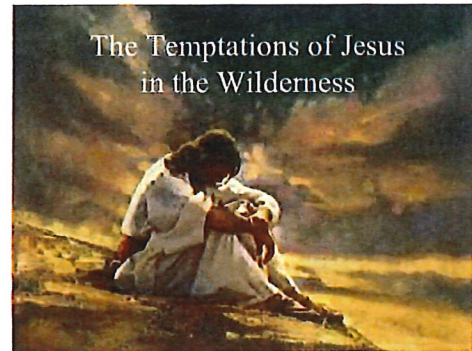
