# Third Sunday of Easter

"We Killed God...and God Still Loves Us"
In today's Gospel, Jesus stood in the midst of two disciples. They were startled and terrified. Why were the disciples terrified? Partly because of the unknown they were experiencing, but also because of guilt. The one they abandoned, betrayed and left for dead is back - maybe for revenge? No, Jesus teaches us that evil met with evil only intensifies, just as fire met with fire only increases the heat. What truly takes away violence is a courageous and compassionate nonviolence, just as water puts out flames. On the cross, the Son of God took on the hatred of all of us sinners, and in his forgiving love, he took that hatred away. He saved us.
