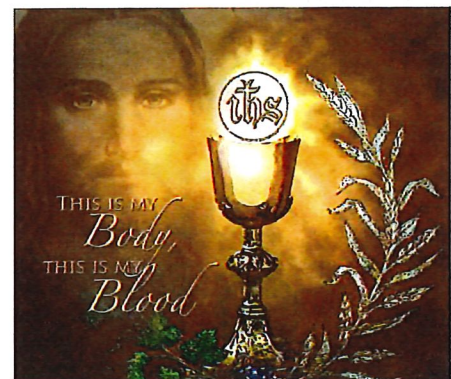


It's not too late! The 14th Annual Sts. Peter & Paul School Golf Tournament is set for Saturday, June 12th with registration starting at 8:30 AM.
