Treasures Of The Church

St. Gregory the Great Parish presents a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on Sunday July 25 at 1 PM. Father Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross will be here with an extraordinary Vatican collection of over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years. There will be relics of St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. A portion of the Veil of Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world will be shown. Bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members, which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.
