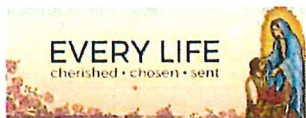

True Presence Mission: The Mystery of the Eucharist

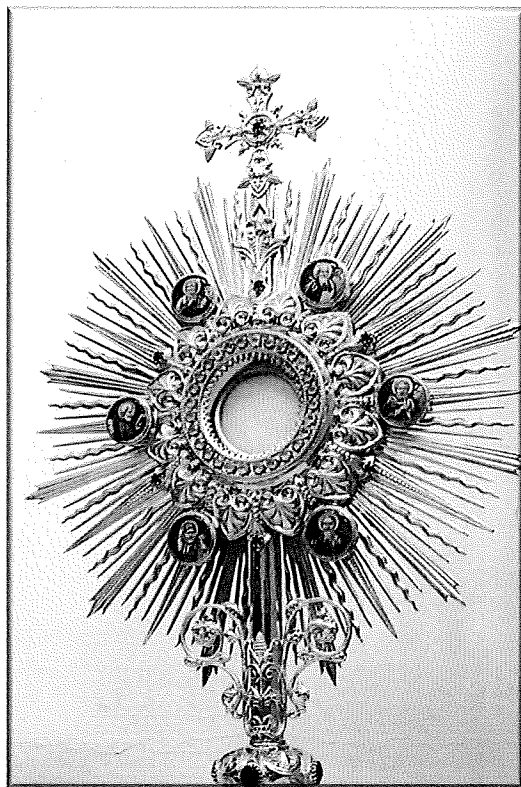
